1. Scaffold support for beam, designed and erected by others.
2. Safety gates at gantry level (GB Access can advise / supply).
3. Clear site access.
4. Craneage to offload/load transport. When HIAB lorry is not utilised.
5. Road traffic management and any associated permits necessary.
6. 3 phase (32Amps) power supply with isolator on gantry.
7. Armoured cable from isolator to junction box on inner end of beam (junction box by GB Access). Connection by Site
8. All risks insurance (GB Access can provide this service).
9. Trained and competent operators (GB Access can provide training).
10. Daily checks & weekly inspections in accordance with current legislation (GB Access can provide this service)

Notes:

- a. All hires will be made in accordance with CPA Model Conditions of Hire including the Supplementary Conditions applicable to Hoists (copies attached). Acceptance of this quotation shall signify acceptance of these conditions.
- b. An order placed with & accepted by GB Access will not signify our acceptance of any terms and conditions attached to the order unless otherwise agreed by GB Access in writing
- c. Terms of payment are strictly nett, due for settlement within 30 days of dated invoice.
- d. Value Added Tax is not included.
- e. Costs are based on Normal Working Hours, Monday to Friday, unless otherwise stated.
- f. Hoist Hire to commence upon delivery to site and will continue daily until the hoist has been completely dismantled and removed from site. (minimum 5 days written notice required).
- g. The weekly hire rate is based on the minimum weeks quoted and may be charged in full if there is a shortfall in the hire duration.
- h. If the minimum hire period overruns, the weekly hire rate will remain fixed.
- i. The quoted prices are based upon information supplied and may require alteration following a site survey.
- j. The equipment specified is offered subject to availability.

Upon completion of the hoist installation, provided it fully complies with the requirements of the thorough examination by a competent person a Thorough Examination Report will be issued and the hoist handed over to the client for use. The user is advised that the safe operation of the hoist and any instructions given to operators is a matter for them and that they need to be aware of their responsibilities in this regard ie hoistway/landing protection, trained operators, daily/weekly inspection etc as required by P.U.W.E.R. 1998 and LOLER 1998.
